



Scholarships

Marvin R. Springer Scholarships

This \$1,000 award is made annually to an entering freshman in the Department of Community and Regional Planning or the Department of Landscape Architecture. The recipients will receive additional amounts of \$1,000 in succeeding years if they meet the conditions for scholarship renewal. The total amount could be \$4,000.

Eligibility

Any graduating high school senior who has applied for admission to Iowa State University and plans to enter either the Department of Community and Regional Planning or the Department of Landscape Architecture may be considered for the awards.

Application Procedure

1. Students must apply for admission to Iowa State University to the Admissions Office, which will include submission of official high school transcripts.
2. Complete the College of Design Scholarship Form (see below on page 3).
3. Have each of the following submit a recommendation form: (1) teacher, (2) an extracurricular or non-school organization supervisor or an employer, (3) a classmate or other peer.
4. A brief statement describing financial need. A [FAFSA](#) must be on file with the Student Financial Aid office.
5. A written statement (of about 300 words) about interests and abilities that suit the applicant for successful career in his/her chosen field of Community and Regional Planning or Landscape Architecture.

Initial Selection

Based upon a review of the application information, the award(s) will be made by a committee that includes the chairs of both departments. While financial need will be a consideration, the primary

criterion will be achievement. The recipients will be those who best combine evidence of high scholarship and potential for leadership in their chosen fields.

Renewal

Scholarships will be automatically renewed for the second year of a student's program provided that:

1. the student in the first year has earned a minimum 2.75 GPA in his/her major course work; and
2. the student is pursuing, on a full-time basis, a degree program in Community and Regional Planning or Landscape Architecture

For subsequent renewals, the student must satisfy the following conditions: (1) must continue enrollment in their initially selected field with a program of courses that will lead to graduation in time which is regularly expected in their curricula; and (2) must have earned a minimum 2.75 overall university grade-point average in their major coursework by the onset of the academic year for renewal.

If a student drops out of school or otherwise fails to meet the conditions for renewal, the scholarship shall be discontinued.

Due Dates

Return the completed scholarship forms with attached interest ability statement to Landscape Architecture office or the Community and Regional Planning office on or before March 1.

Submit your application for ISU admissions (including high school transcripts) directly to the Admissions Office (100 Alumni Hall, Ames, IA 50011) before the deadline above.

The scholarship committee needs to receive your letters of recommendation before the deadline.
