



Art and Design Excellence Scholarships

This scholarship is awarded to a student or students who are majors in the Department of Art and Design for at least one semester. They must have at least one semester remaining, be making satisfactory progress towards a degree, and have minimum GPA of 3.0. These scholarships include Benbrook-Lapp, Peterson-Anderson, Kirke, and Warburton. Students will be considered for all scholarships for which they are eligible. The scholarship will be awarded as Fall or Fall/ Spring tuition payment in the upcoming academic year.

To apply for this scholarship submit the following to room 158 Design by March 1:

1. Submit College of Design Scholarship Form by March 1(see below on page 2).
2. Request two faculty members complete and return the Scholarships/Awards Recommendation Forms (see below on page 3).
3. Submit a resume highlighting your extra curricular and volunteer activities, honors and awards received, and cumulative grade point average. Also include the names of the two faculty members submitting the Scholarships/Awards Recommendation Forms.
4. A current FAFSA must be on file with the Financial Aid Office to be considered for the Kirke scholarship. The remaining Art and Design Excellence scholarships (Benbrook-Lapp, Peterson-Anderson, and Warburton) do not require financial need.
