Selected Extension Activities and Accomplishments

ISU Design West (2007 – present)

- An ongoing program in Sioux City in partnership with the Greater Sioux City Chamber of Commerce.
- Has involved over 200 College of Design students and a dozen College of Design faculty and staff in urban outreach and Extension projects.
- Projects included design workshops for middle school and high school students.
- College of Design students completed bus stops and works of art, concrete cabins in a camp ground as shelters, way finding in the historic courthouse, freeway design and integration into the downtown and riverfront areas, a studio on the urban environment and local foods systems, and student assistance to fund raising events for local charities.
- The program was recognized in 2010 by the University Economic Development Association by receiving the it national partnership award.

Town/Craft Center (PI) (2007 – present)

- Serve as PI on the Town/Craft Center. A program based in Perry, Iowa that focuses upon identifying innovative and creative alternatives to small town revitalization and development.
- Initiated with \$747,000 grant from Hometown Perry Inc. and \$2,000,000 donated renovation of the facility completed in part by students in the College of Design “Design Build” Class.
- Have held a series of roundtable sessions on such topics as Latino Entrepreneurship, civic engagement, the elder friendly community, measuring community sustainability, community economic development and the bioeconomy, community planning and local food systems, and housing policy.
- Provided a forum for regional program planning through a roundtable of region’s CRED program leaders and selected speakers.
- Provided a studio space for College of Design courses to conduct off-campus field in Perry that led to changes in the downtown area.
- Provided a genesis for new Extension programming and partnerships.
- Program will continue with City of Perry as partner.

Bioeconomy Extension Program (2007)

- Co-chaired ISU Extension Bioeconomy Task Force
- Helped organize a webcast broadcast combined with local county focus groups to gain feedback on ISU Biotechnology and Bioeconomy research and outreach. Over 1000 participated in 96 counties.
- Developed and coordinated a one-day public policy education conference on the Future of the Small Town in the Bioeconomy. Invited speakers included Chet

- A new web site function as an “Amazon.com” for community and economic development in Iowa.
- The site presently highlights ISU Extension programming but will allow local officials to access multiple agencies and build multi-year community and economic development programs through a single contract.

Des Moines Nonprofit Management Institute (PI) (1999 – present)

- Over a thousand attend workshops annually.
- Over 100 certificates awarded for continual participation.
- Joint effort with United Way in Des Moines.

- Only program of its kind in Iowa.
- Helped create the “academies” model that has been replicated by other programs within ISU Extension.

- Over 2000 Extension projects and activities have been entered into the database from across Iowa.

Tomorrow's Leaders Today (PI) (1985 – present)

- Winner of ISU Extension Achievement Award.
- Over 1500 citizens participated in the yearlong curriculum that resulted in the development of over two dozen associations or non-profit organizations.
- This \$1 million Extension program, funded in part by the W.K. Kellogg Foundation and the Iowa Department of Economic Development, offered rural leaders opportunities to work through collaborative development efforts with nearby communities.
- Adapted to urban setting through COPC program.

Community Visioning (Co-PI) (1996 – present)

- Over 110 communities have completed this community design program, involving citizen input through charettes, workshops, and computer imaging.
- This outreach and applied research program has resulted in almost one million dollars in grants and contracts to the College of Design and ISU Extension annually.
- Provided annual community training to both Landscape Architects and students involved in project.
- Assisted in the project's initial design.
- A database has been developed with great potential for more basic research.
- Received national awards from the American Planning Association and the Federal Highway Administration, also received a regional award from the American Society of Landscape Architects and the Iowa Planning Association.

RESEARCH AND CREATIVE ACTIVITIES

Current and Past Projects

Town/Craft (2007 to present)

- Developed through a three and a half-year \$754,000 grant through Hometown Perry, Iowa (Roberta and Howard Amundson).
- Local facility provided by a \$1.5 million renovation of a local bank building.
- New research and outreach center will focus upon the developing alternative futures for Midwestern small communities.
- Facility includes space for student design studios, visiting professors, Extension staff and exhibition space.
- Funding also provides for symposia, policy and idea roundtables, graduate assistantships, and pilot outreach projects.
- Resident Extension staff is charged with diffusing findings and proceedings of Town/Craft activities, research and outreach.

Iowa Planning Inventory (2003)

- Complete inventory of planning and zoning of Iowa's counties and municipalities.
- Over 95% response rate from municipalities and 100% from counties.
- Subsequent report used in legislature in relation to local planning enabling legislation debate.
- From inventory, developed an archive of Iowa's local plans and zoning ordinances that have been accessed by studios, faculty and state agencies.

Multi-community Development Organizations (1992 - 2005)

- Three inventories of Iowa's Multi-community Development Organizations (MDOs) have been conducted since 1990 and a future inventory is planned next year.
- Some of these studies have been funded in part by the Iowa Department of Economic Development and has resulted in three graduate research assistantships.
- The longitudinal data generated by these inventories has led to four peer reviewed publications, Extension bulletins, theses generated by graduate students, and an interactive page on the College of Design web site.

Iowa Shared Services Study (1994)

- A complete census of the all shared governmental service arrangements among Iowa's 99 counties and 950 municipalities was completed through a contract with the Iowa Department of Economic Development.
- The study resulted in the creation of a Shared Governmental Services program sponsored by the Iowa Department of Economic Development to plan and fund demonstrations among local governments.
- The study also resulted in a peer-reviewed publication.

Iowa in Motion (2000)

- Related to the development of Iowa's ISTEA state long-range transportation plan.
- The project entailed external funding from the Iowa Department of Transportation in excess of \$250,000, and included a random sample survey, the orchestration and documentation of 20 public meetings at 20 locations.
- Three graduate research assistantships were funded through this project.

IOWACCESS Project 6 (1998- 2001)

- Received the Vice-Presidential "Hammer" Award for efficient government.
- Project resulted in a joint web site supported by HUD, Fannie Mae, the Iowa Finance Authority and the Iowa Department of Economic Development.
- Iowa residents can access information on not only what housing financial programs they are eligible, but also what banks and other financial institution support those programs within a given location.
- Other information includes subsidized housing availability and counseling availability.
- Total external funds received for this research exceeded \$130,000.
- Four research assistantships were funded by this project.

Community Visualization and Local Planning (2004 to Present)

- Completed training on the ESRI software extension entitled “Community Viz”.
- This package contains policy assessment and 3-D simulation routines on top of the standard GIS package.
- Organized local demonstrations to test relationships between computer generated visual representations and local decision-making and planning.
- Helped organized the development of a new GIS lab in the College of Design for research and Extension involving funding from the College of Design, the ISU Extension Service, and the ISU President. The lab was designed and built through an architecture studio of fifth year students.
