*A second major or minor must be approved by the department offering the program of study. A student MUST have a coherent 30-hour, department-approved program OR a minor and enough credit hours in a coherent department-approved program to equal 30 hours.

Approval for these 30 credits must be documented in writing following completion of 75 credits and before completion of 90 credits toward the BA degree.

**Remaining credits sufficient to complete graduation requirements for a minimum of 120.5 credits. In most cases this will be 12 credits. No more than four courses at the 200 level in ARTIS, ARTGR, and ARTID may be used to fulfill requirements or electives for the BA in Art and Design.
