CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

ARTID 551A: Design humanics – Sensory perception & ergonomic factors: Significantly redesigned course. Developed new lectures, assignments, reading materials, projects, and in-class activities. Especially, this class have a joint project of smart home design with studentss in Geron-technology class (COM 414+514) and gerontology (Geron 563).

ARTID 552: Design Method (Spring 2019): Designed new course. Developed course materials, syllabus, weekly schedule, assignments, grading rubrics, lectures, in-class activities and projects. This course introduced Evidence-based Design which is a process for the conscientious, explicit, and judicious use of current best evidence from research and practice in making critical decisions. This class explores how to find, evaluate and synthesize evidence and translate it for design application in a physical environment.

DSN S 3: Wellness Studio (Spring 2019): Significantly redesigned course. Following the learning objectives outlined by previous instructor, I and Cameron have significantly redesigned course materials, syllabus, lectures, field trip plan, and design projects. In this year, the studio focused on residential and healthcare facilities for our aging population.
