Complete 3.0 credits from any of the departments in the College of Design: Architecture (ARCH), Art History (ART H), Interior Design (ARTID), Graphic Design (ARTGR), Integrated Studio Arts (ARTIS), Community and Regional Planning (C R P), Design (DES), Design Studies (DSN S), Industrial Design (IND D), or Landscape Architecture (L A)

General Electives (21 Credits)
Complete 6.0 credits from course level 300-500
Complete 15.0 additional credits with the following exceptions:
1) No more than 9 credits of Architecture (ARCH) courses total including above requirement (NOTE: No ARCH courses may be P/NP)
2) Only 2.0 credits of Kinesiology (KIN) or Athletics (ATH) can be used towards the degree
3) Only 4.0 credits of ROTC courses can be used (AFAS, M S, N S) can be used as electives
4) <i>Courses below the minimum requirements of English 150, Math 145, and Physics 111 (for example, ENGL 10, 99, 101; MATH 25, 30) are NOT applied to the degree program</i>

Notes
*Six credits of Humanities and/or Social Sciences must be earned during the First Year CORE Program.
*Up to nine credits of general electives offered by other departments may be taken as pass/not pass.
*Architecture courses taken in fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Architecture MUST be taken for grade, including those taken to fulfill general elective requirements
*Communication courses also offered as a Humanities and/or Social Sciences may only be used <u>once</u> . An additional course must be taken to fulfill the other requirement.

<u>English Proficiency</u>
