# Divided or United


## 18th Annual Postcard Print Exchange

### Requirements:

- **I. Theme**: The phrase "United we stand, divided we fall" encourages groups to collaboratively work together. It speaks to the strength of collective efforts and the problems related to divisiveness. You can explore these thematic possibilities or focus solely on formal visual concerns related to pieces related to the whole.
- II. Any **EDITIONABLE** printmaking technique may be used. (woodcut, lithography, intaglio, photography, silkscreen, digital prinmaking, etc) **Please DO NOT send monoprints/monotypes.**Each of the prints sent must be identical to the others.

III. Size: 4" x 6" (They can be folded to this size). Note: if you make a folded print, consider donating a larger amount to cover the increased cost. Thanks.

IV. 13 identical prints should be sent individually to the address posted below. Each card must be stamped and will bear the markings of travel and the postal service. Do not send the cards together in one envelope.
