

CELT Programming Faculty Fellow (2019-2021)

We invite tenured Iowa State University faculty to apply for a half-time position as CELT Faculty Fellow within the Center for Excellence in Learning and Teaching. This faculty fellow will provide leadership for selected faculty programming within CELT with opportunities to broaden their understanding of and experience in academic administration.

The fellow will work with the Director of CELT to enhance and expand the faculty programming work of CELT. The areas of focus will be (1) ideation, development and leadership of a Teaching and Learning Academy for new faculty members at ISU and the 2) leadership of the Teaching Partners Program. The final portfolio of responsibilities will be jointly determined by the fellow and the CELT director. Candidates should have a demonstrated interest in and experience with teaching and mentoring excellence.

This Faculty Fellow will have a half-time, two-year administrative appointment in the Division of Academic Affairs and will serve as part of CELT's administrative team. S/he will be provided with 50% release time for the 2019-2021 academic years beginning January 2019 or August 2019, negotiable. In the case of B-base faculty, the Fellow may also receive partial support for work carried out in the summers. CELT will provide the Fellow with resources needed to carry out their administrative duties, as well as opportunities for professional development. The Fellows will retain office space in their home department, as well as other ordinary faculty services and prerogatives.

Eligibility:

Any tenured professor at Iowa State is eligible. All applicants should be on full-time appointments and should have been employed at ISU for at least five years.
