Application Guidelines for the MArch and M.S. in Architecture

The priority application consideration date for both programs is **January 4**. Any applications received after the priority consideration date will be reviewed only as program resources permit.

REQUIRED ITEMS:

- ISU Graduate College Admission Application:** www.admissions.iastate.edu/apply
- Application Fee:** \$60 for U.S. residents; \$100 for international applicants
- Official Academic Transcripts**

- Three (3) Letters of Recommendation:**
Recommendations should come from 3 individuals who can speak most directly about your ability to complete graduate level coursework & teaching duties. These individuals can be from your educational or professional background. You may choose to have either an electronic or paper recommendation submitted; however, electronic is preferred. When you complete the ISU Graduate College Admission Application, there is a section where you can indicate the names and email addresses for your three references. When you submit your application, those three individuals will receive an email notification from ISU Admissions with a link to the recommendation form. When they complete and submit the form online, it will automatically be tied back to your electronic application.
- Statement of Academic and Professional Interests:**
Include your interests, career goals, and reasons for applying to the program. Describe academic as well as professional preparation. Be specific when describing your areas of interest. (500 words maximum)
- Digital Portfolio:**
Include a minimum of 5 examples of your creative work. This can be architectural, artistic, craft, photography or any medium that helps us understand how you connect your thinking and making. Digital submission (PDF or website) is required. When you reach the last page of your admission application, you may upload your portfolio with a maximum size of 20 MB. If your portfolio is website-based, please upload a PDF document that indicates the website where your portfolio may be viewed.
- TOEFL, IELTS, or Duolingo English Proficiency Scores (for international applicants only):**
The TOEFL or IELTS is required for applicants whose native language is not English. This requirement may be waived if a bachelor's or master's degree was received from a school in the USA or another country where English is the only official language. A minimum TOEFL score of 550 (paper-based), 79 (internet-based), an IELTS score of 6.5, or a Duolingo score of 105 is required for admission is required.
- Research Proposal (for M.S. applicants only):**
In the first instance, you should send a 500-1000 word outline of your research proposal to the Director of Graduate Education, Dr Douglas Spencer at dcs1@iastate.edu who will then advise in due course of any faculty suitable and potentially available to undertake supervision for the proposed topic prior to the formal application procedure. The outline should include reference to the research question to be addressed, the methods, means and goals of the research to be undertaken, identification of existing literature, agenda and timeline of research, applicants record of previous study, work, research and publication in the area, supervisory faculty you are interested in working with. Please do not contact faculty directly with your inquiry before undertaking this process.
