Registration Steps during advising appointment:

1. Register for DSN S 102 & DSN S 131 **OR** DSN S 102 **OR** DSN S 131
DSN S 102 students must take DSN S 132
2. Register for DSN S 115
3. Register for DSN S 183
4. Register for ENGL 150* **OR** ENGL 250*
OR General Education Elective
5. Register for MATH** **OR** Science
6. Register for Humanities **OR** Social Science
7. Enroll in U ST 110
8. If you plan to participate in band or choir, register for the assigned course(s).

Note: Community & Regional Planning transfer majors are not required to complete DSN S 131/102/132/183/115. They will take required CRP classes instead.

** Placement for MATH courses based on ALEKS Placement test score. Your advisor will have your placement.
