<p>Registration Steps during advising appointment:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Register for DSNS 1020 & DSNS 1310 OR DSNS 1310 OR DSNS 1020. DSNS 1020 students must take DSNS 1320. 2. Register for DSNS 1150. 3. Register for DSNS 1830 OR General Education Elective. 4. Register for ENGL based on placement* OR General Education Elective. 5. Register for MATH** OR Science. 6. Register for Humanities OR Social Science. 7. If you plan to participate in band, choir, or athletics, register for the assigned course(s). <p>Note: Community & Regional Planning transfer majors are not required to complete DSNS 1310/1020/1320/1150. They will take DSNS 1830 and required CRP classes instead.</p>

* Your advisor will have your English placement, if English is not already complete.

** Placement for MATH courses based on ALEKS Placement test score. Your advisor will have your placement.

Before your registration appointment you must complete two very simple tasks!!! **First**, identify time preferences for your required DSNS 1020 or DSNS 1310 studio course.
